Competition Description

To evaluate a team of two competitor's ability to develop, execute, document and present a project that was completed in their community or school, and which provides a benefit or learning experience to the community or school. This event also enables the community to become aware of the outstanding work being performed by career and technical education students.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

The competition will require the competitors to develop and execute a project in their community or school. Documentation or recording of the events will be maintained in a SkillsUSA notebook to be presented at the competition. The presentation shall last a minimum of 5 minutes and a maximum of 10 minutes and will include an explanation of the purpose and scope of the project, how the project was developed, methods used, implementation and execution of the project and its results

Clothing Requirement

National Requirement: Class A: SkillsUSA Official Attire

- Official SkillsUSA red blazer or official SkillsUSA red jacket
- Button-up, collared, white dress shirt (accompanied by a plain, solid black tie or SkillsUSA black tie), white shirt (collarless or small-collared) or white turtleneck, with any collar not to extend into the lapel area of the blazer, sweater, windbreaker or jacket
- Black dress slacks or skirt (knee-length at minimum)
- Black dress shoes

State Requirement:

SkillsUSA Official Attire or Business Professional Attire.

Provided by Competitor

- SkillsUSA three-ring notebook documenting the project, which will be on display for one day after the presentation. *Note binders can be picked up from HQ on Saturday.
- Presentation media, such as a laptop computer, poster boards, etc.
- If using electronic presentation media, bring a flash drive for backup.
- Cable specific for the laptop and the projector, if using a laptop.
- Backup presentation media should be available in case of technical difficulties.
- Eligibility letter from a school official
- All competitors must submit a one-page resume.
- HDMI to USB-C cable

Provided by Technical Committee

- Timekeeper
- A projector and screen with be provided if using electronic media; however, cabling must be provided by the competitor.
