### **Competition Description**

Competitors demonstrate their knowledge and ability to perform entry-level procedures pulled from the National core standards

#### Tasks To Be Evaluated

For this specific competition, competitors will be expected to give a 5-7 minute presentation on a healthcare topic of their choice. The presentation will be judged on:

- Professionalism
- Knowledge of the topic presented
- Ability to present within the time constraints

Competitors will then participate in a small group simulation in which they will be judged in ability to

- Demonstrate teamwork, delegation, and safe patient care
- The simulation includes basic assessment of an infant and emergency care of an adult

### **Provided by Competitor**

 Competitors should wear scrubs with are a solid color and a watch with a second hand.

### **Provided by Technical Committee**

• Medical equipment needed for competition.

#### **Additional Information**

- Contestants must come prepared to deliver a presentation with visual aids which may be no larger than 30"x30"x30"
- Three sided poster display boards are permitted
- If the presentation is digital, the student must provide the means to display presentation content. No laptop or monitor will be provided
- Employer and manufacturer trade names must be covered or removed. The presentation will neither promote nor advertise any commercial organization or product.

## Career Competition

### **Clothing Requirement**

### National Requirement:

#### Class B: Health care attire

- Official blue scrubs, white socks or skin-tone seamless hose and health professional's white leather work shoes
- Shoes must be all white leather (no canvas) and completely enclosed (no open toe or heel)
- Athletic-style shoes that meet the aforementioned criteria are acceptable

### **State Requirement:**

National requirement OR

- Scrubs should fit appropriately for all health competitions and should be properly hemmed and wrinkle free.
- Only plain, white, collarless T-shirts may be worn underneath the scrubs.
- Hair must be pinned up and off the collar.
- White socks or white seamless/nonpattern hose visible above the top of the shoe.
- Health professionals white or black leather work shoes.
- Shoes must be all-white or black leather (no canvas/mesh), completely enclosed (no open-toe or open-heel).
- Athletic-style shoes that meet the criteria are acceptable.
- Any embroidered names or school patches must be covered, if applicable.
