# THE CHAMPIONSHIPS: QUALIFYING EVENTS

Thousands of SkillsUSA Illinois members partake in the annual Qualifying Events every winter. These regional career competitions serve as the gateway to compete in The Championships, Illinois' Elite Career Competitions. Chapters are encouraged to host local career competitions before advancing members to the Qualifying Events process.

### **INFORMATION**

### **OVERVIEW**

Members can qualify for The Championships: Illinois Elite Career Competitions through the Regional Qualifying Events or Qualifying Exams, attending a conference is not required. Students must complete a Qualifying Exam if they wish to register for a Regional Qualifying Event. All competitors must be members of SkillsUSA, by the RQE registration deadline.

Regional Qualifying Events will advance a specific number of students, per competitive event, based on the qualifying event formula. Qualifying Exams will establish a state-wide ranking in the qualifying competitions. SkillsUSA Illinois will use this list to fill the remaining open positions in the career competition once the qualifiers from the Regional Qualifying Events have been placed. Students will not be required to participate in a Regional Qualifying Event, to be eligible for the SkillsUSA Illinois Championships.

### **EVENT COSTS**

### **Qualifying Exams**

\$10 per exam; multiple exams can be completed

### **Regional Qualifying Event**

\$55 per registrant (students and professionals) one competition per student.

### **REGIONAL QUALIFYING EVENT ASSIGNMENT**

SkillsUSA Illinois chapters North of Pontiac, IL will compete at the Regional Qualifying Event – North on February 28 at Wilco Area Career Center - Romeoville, IL.

SkillsUSA Illinois chapters South of Pontiac, IL will compete at the State Qualifying Conference – South on February 7 at Capital Area Career Center and Lincoln Land Community College - Springfield, IL.

# ADVANCING TO THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

SkillsUSA Illinois will advance students to The Championships based on the following criteria.

- A minimum of 15 students are registered in the individual competition at the Regional Qualifying Event
- 35% of competitor allotment at The Championships will advance from each of the Regional Qualifying Event

All other available spots will be then filled based on student scores for the Qualifying Exams.

### **QUALIFYING EXAMS**

### **EXAM INFORMATION**

### **CAREER COMPETITION EXAM(S)**

Exams range from 50 to 100 questions on specific technical area.

Students enrolled in more than one Career and Technical area may take a qualifying exam in more than one area. When a student is registered for two exams, the advisor MUST indicate a preferred competition for the student.

### **CAREER READINESS EXAM**

50 questions based on the SkillsUSA Framework, SkillsUSA Career Essentials: Foundations, and SkillsUSA general knowledge.

This exam is used as a tie-breaker for students who have tied scores at the cut off line. This is exam is 2.5% of every competition score card and is also used as a tiebreaker at the State Championship.

### **EXAM ADMINISTRATION**

### **EXAM WINDOW**

SkillsUSA Illinois Qualifying Exams will be available online, January 31 - February 7, 2025 from 6AM to 6PM daily. To test outside of these times, contact the State Office by emailing membership@SkillsUSAIllinois.org.

### **ADMINISTERING EXAMS**

Exams should not be administered by a SkillsUSA advisor or content area teacher; an administrator or outside department teacher is recommended.

Each student will use their personal Salesforce sign in to access the exams. Students will have one hour to complete the exam.
